## READ THESE PAPERS CAREFULLY!

Upon the filing of a Complaint, the Tribal court shall set an expeditious trial date, which shall not be more than thirty (30) calendar days from the date of filing the Complaint. The Court may grant an extension based on the consent of both parties to the suit.

You must "appear" in this case or judgement may be taken against you if you fail to appear or answer. To "appear" you must file with the court a legal document called an "answer." The "answer" must be filed pursuant to Chapter 68,12(g) and must be served on the Housing Department or their attorney no later than five (5) days prior to the scheduled trial date.
